Committee Updates:

- Staffing
 - The County has officially opened the portals on the job website for Election Aide and Senior Election Aide positions. To date, nearly 350 applicants have completed the application.
 - The Service Club program is back; currently, 12 clubs are in touch with the Elections
 Office about working the 2024 Primary. All members must pass a background check and
 go through training.

Voter Information Guides

- The VIG pages are not ready to be presented at the December meeting but cannot be held until the January meeting, as that will be too late.
- LAAC members will be sent a PDF packet of the completed draft within the next few days and are asked to provide feedback.
- The new VIG will be combined for all major parties; there will no longer be VIGs with cover pages specific to political parties.
